Visitors Expectations Fact Sheet
For FULLY Vaccinated Visitors and Residents

- **Fully vaccinated** shall be defined as being 2 weeks post receiving the 2nd dose of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or 2 weeks post receiving a single dose of the J&J vaccine.
- All fully vaccinated family members/designated representatives who will be visiting a fully vaccinated resident of the facility must produce documentation of being vaccinated. The visiting person will be issued a photo identification badge which will be used at the reception desk to enter the facility. Badges will be made Monday through Friday between 9am and 3pm.
- Visiting for those who are fully vaccinated and have a badge, will be starting on July 16, 2021 with open visiting, seven days a week
- Fully vaccinated visitors may go to the unit of the resident and bring the resident to the main recreation/dining room. If the resident does not have a roommate or are in a private room, then visitation may occur in the room.
- Visitors with badge will be required to complete a screen for : signs and symptoms of COVID-19, recent exposure and temperature prior to resident access and visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening questions.
- Documentation must include the following for each visitor to the nursing home: first and last name of the visitor; physical (street) address of the visitor; daytime and evening telephone number; date and time of visit; and email address, if available.
- No more than 20 percent (20%) of the residents shall have visitors at any one time and only two visitors will be allowed per resident at any one time.
- Visitors under the age of 16 must be fully vaccinated with a badge and be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older who was issued a badge
- Visitors must wear a face mask or face covering which covers both the nose and mouth at all times when on the premises of the NH/ACF's.
- Visitors must maintain social distancing, except when assisting with wheelchair mobility.
- Facility will provide alcohol-based hand rub, consisting of at least 60 percent (60%) alcohol, to residents, visitors and representatives of the long-term care ombudsman prior to visiting the residents. Rub hands together using friction.
- **The staff is required to monitor the visitation process. If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.**
